# EXPERIENCE SYDNEY

Sydney's CBD reflects Sydney's continuous dominance in the Australian market as a preferred safe haven destination for international students and has consistently drawn over 50% of all higher education students in Australia (Source AEI).

**Summer (December – February)** - During summer, average temperatures range from 18.6 - 25.8°C (65.5 - 78.4°F)

**Autumn (March – May)** - Autumn is the mildest time of year in Sydney when the humidity drops and average temperatures fall between 14.6 - 22.2°C (58.3 - 72°F)

**Winter (June – August)** - Sydney's winter months are June to August when average temperatures drop between 8.8 - 17°C (47.8 - 62.6°F).

**Spring (September – November)** - In spring, days are warmer but the humidity is not as high as summer. Average daily temperatures range from 11 - 23°C (51.8 - 73.4°F)

## Cost of Living

The 12-month living costs are:

- ⊗ For students or guardians - AUD\$21,041
- ⊗ For partners coming with you - AUD\$7,362
- ⊗ For a child coming with you - AUD\$3,152

## Accommodation

- ⊗ Hostels and Guesthouses - \$90 to \$150 per week
- ⊗ Shared Rental - \$95 to \$215 per week
- ⊗ Homestay - \$235 to \$325 per week
- ⊗ Rental - \$185 to \$440 per week
- ⊗ Boarding schools - \$11,000 to \$22,000 a year

## Other living expenses

- ⊗ Groceries and eating out - \$140 to \$280 per week
- ⊗ Gas, electricity - \$10 to \$20 per week
- ⊗ Phone and Internet - \$15 to \$30 per week
- ⊗ Public transport - \$30 to \$60 per week
- ⊗ Car (after purchase) - \$150 to \$260 per week
- ⊗ Entertainment - \$80 to \$150 per week

## Education costs

The list below gives you a broad indication of the range of course costs (yearly) for different types of qualifications.

- ⊗ School - \$7,800 to \$30,000
- ⊗ English language studies - Around \$300 per week depending on course length
- ⊗ Vocational Education and Training (Certificates to IV, Diploma and Advanced Diploma) - \$4,000 to \$22,000
- ⊗ Undergraduate Bachelor Degree - \$20,000 to \$45,000
- ⊗ Postgraduate Masters Degree - \$22,000 to \$50,000
- ⊗ Doctoral Degree - \$18,000 to \$42,000

## Academic requirements

Student must have completed at least one year of study at their home university

## English requirements

Students whose first language is not English will need to provide evidence of English language proficiency:

### 🌀 IELTS

Overall Band Score 6.0 with a minimum sub-score of 5.5 in writing, reading, speaking and listening

### 🌀 TOEFL ( Paper Based Test)

500-549 with a minimum score of 4.5 in the Test of Written English (TWE) and 50 in Listening and Reading

### 🌀 TOEFL (Internet Based Test (iBT))

60-78 with a writing score of 18 and reading, speaking and listening scores of 16

### 🌀 PTE Academic (Pearson Test of English)

Overall score 50 with no skill score under 42

### 🌀 CAE (Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English)

Grade C (52-57)

### 🌀 CPE (Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English)

Grade of C (45) or better
