Bachelor of International Business

This program provides students with foundational knowledge and skills drawn from those disciplines which are essential in the management of a modern business – accounting, statistics and data management, business information systems and communications.

IBUS 101 Introduction to International Business

Tuesday: 6pm to 9pm

Basic management principles to the international arena. The environment of international business, including politics, culture and economics, are emphasized.

BMKT101 - Business Marketing

Thursday: 6pm to 9pm

This unit provides students with the fundamentals of marketing theory and practice within the global business environment. Students will learn how to interpret the role of business marketing, and to analyse markets and market characteristics.

Bachelor of Enterprise Management Systems

This program focuses on the special challenges associated with selecting, installing and supporting systems that support business processes, data analytics and information flows within an organisation and with key external parties such as suppliers and customers, across a wide range of sectors and industries.

IEMS 101 Introduction to Enterprise Management Systems

Tuesday: 2pm to 5pm

This unit provides students with an understanding of Enterprise Management Systems (EMS) and the associated issues of selecting, implementing and using these types of systems.

ICS101 Introduction to Cyber Security

Thursday: 2pm to 5pm

This unit will provide the students with introductory knowledge and skills of cyber safety, knowledge of proactive approaches that address the complex social situations and behaviours that manifest in the online world.
